Multiage Grades

The multiage model is growing to include students in grades 3 and 4. This model has academic, social and emotional benefits for students. It makes learning more personalized, based on students' needs and interests.

Although there are a broad range of abilities in a multiage classroom, students are one class of learners, working together. This prompted us to change the name of these classes. PK & K will be called Early Primary, 1&2 is Primary and 3&4 is Intermediate. Next year when grades 5&6 implement multiage, we will call them Upper Intermediate.

Changes to Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Our Safety and Security Committee recommended changes to drop off and pick up procedures. Busses will drop students off and pick students up using the lower driveway. Students riding the bus will enter and leave the building through the hallway between the art room and cafeteria. Parents and guardians who drive their children to and from school will use the upper driveway. Adults will stop the car at the main entrance and children will walk to the building, where a staff member will meet them. At the end of the day, cars will form a line starting at the main entrance and students will be dismissed in order by a staff member.
